Beach Safety

Reduce your risk of beach theft and stop thieves from ruining your day at the beach.

Things to remember:

- Secure your car and don't leave bags or valuables on car seats.
- Mobile phones, wallets and bags are prime target for beach thieves. DO NOT leave them unattended.
- Leave someone to look after your property by alternating your swim with a friend or family member.
- Do not leave your property with a stranger.
- Lockers are available at some beaches.



- Always remember to swim
- between the red and yellow flags.
